CUSTOMER GUIDE TO RETURNING YOUR RECALLED MIRROR

Glass is fragile and with the concerns highlighted in our recall notice is it essential the product is removed from your home and returned to your local store for a full refund. The guidance below will help reduce the chance of the mirror being damaged and injury occurring when the mirror is moved.

2 large sheets of corrugated cardboard/

large cardboard box if available

The mirror will require careful preparation for return to store. Given the risk of breakage, appropriate wrapping and transport by car to your local store is essential.

Materials you will need;

- Gloves
- Masking tape
- Packing/parcel/clear tape
- A blanket
- Bubble wrap if available
 Scissors.

! ALWAYS USE GLOVES WHEN HANDLING THE MIRROR.

! ASK FOR ASSISTANCE FROM ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL IF REQUIRED.

- 1. Read this removal advice fully before beginning the removal of your mirror.
- 2. Prepare an area large enough to accommodate the mirror on a floor with a soft surface such as a carpet or rug/blanket. A thick blanket (or a couple of thinner ones) on the surface will serve as a soft cushion during the packing process. Then, place the cardboard nearby.
- **3.** With care lift the mirror from the fixed location to the prepared area. If mechanical fixings have been used please refer to the installation instructions to reverse them.
 - **A.** If the mirror includes a shelf, detach this by unscrewing the fixings. Set the glass to one side and wrap in the same way as the mirror.
 - **B.** If lights are a feature of your mirror a competent person should un-install the electrical connection and the mirror removed as per the following steps.
- 4. Lay the mirror flat on the prepared area.
- 5. Carefully apply the masking tape to the front of the mirror in a grid pattern, wrapping the ends of the tape onto the back of the mirror. This will protect the glass from separating in the unlikely event it is damaged in transit.
- 6. Flatten out the cardboard/cardboard box, trim its size to match the mirror. Cover completely the surface of the mirror with the cut-out section of cardboard, then fix it on the mirror front using small pieces of packing tape. If possible, repeat on the reverse of the mirror.
- 7. If available, wrap the mirror with bubble wrap and secure with tape. Carefully transport the mirror in a car to your local store for a full refund.
