



Before you start

01 Intended use

This work platform is designed for a maximum load of 150 kg. It is intended for use by one person. This product is intended to support one person at the time allowing access to higher areas. The product is designed for temporary indoor use. The product may not be used as shelf or for other long-term applications. For safety reasons it is essential to read the entire instruction manual before first operation and to observe all the instructions therein.

This product is intended for private domestic use only, not for any commercial trade use. It must not be used for any purposes other than those described.

02 Operation

- Only use the product, if you have been trained and instructed.
- · Make sure the product it is free from damage or wear and functions properly.
- Fully unfold the product and place it on a flat stable ground before use. Ensure that there is enough space around the product during your work.




WARNING: Secure the product against unauthorised access (e.g. by children) when it is not in use!

03 Unfolding

NOTE: Always adjust the product on an even and flat surface to avoid slipping of locking devices.

- Unfold the supporting legs (3) and secure them with the locking devices (hooks) (2) (Fig. 1).
- Ensure the locking devices (hooks) (2) are properly engaged in position.
- Never attempt to climb / step onto the product without the locking devices (hooks) properly engaged.
- Slightly twist the supporting legs, if necessary, so that the locking devices (hooks) can be easily released from the LOCK position.

Repair, maintenance and storage

01 Cleaning

- · Clean the product with a dry cloth. Use a brush for areas that are hard to reach.
- In particular inspect all moving parts after every use and lubricate with an oil-cloth.
- · Remove stubborn dirt with compressed air (max. 3 bar).

NOTE: Do not use chemical, alkaline, abrasive or other aggressive detergents or disinfectants to clean this product as they might cause damage to its surfaces.

Check for worn or damaged parts. Replace worn parts as necessary or contact an authorised service centre for repair before using the product again.

02 Maintenance

Before and after each use, check the product and accessories or attachments for wear and damage. If required, exchange them for new ones as described in this instruction manual. Observe the technical requirements.

Lubrication

Regularly check the moving parts and locking devices of the product. Oil these parts regularly.

Feet and support legs

Always ensure that the rubber feet on the supporting legs are securely fixed and free from damage.



WARNING: Never use this product without rubber feet properly and securely attached!

03 Repair

This product does not contain any parts that can be repaired by the consumer. Contact a qualified person to have it checked and repaired.

04 Storage

- Clean the product as described above.
- · Disengage the locking devices (hooks) and fully fold the product.
- Store the product and its accessories in a dark, dry, frost-free, well-ventilated place. The ideal storage temperature is between 10 °C and 30 °C.
- Always store the product in a place that is inaccessible to children.
- We recommend using the original packaging for storage or covering the product with a suitable cloth or enclosure to protect it against dust.

05 Transportation

- · Disengage the locking devices (hooks) and fully fold the product.
- Protect the product from any heavy impact or strong vibrations which may occur during transportation in vehicles.
- · Secure the product to prevent it from slipping or falling over.
- Hold the product firmly when carrying it.
