User Instructions











1. Download

Scan the QR code to download the Link Sensio App. Alternatively, the app can be downloaded from the App Store or Google Play store by searching for 'Link Sensio'.

From the Home Management page you will be able to edit, create or join a home. A home is already created when you log in to the app so press My Home to add your details. You will now be able to set a house name and location, as well as choosing what rooms you have in your home.

Please note: Setting up a home is not essential, but it is a great way to keep you devices organised.



4. Adding Devices

From the Home page, press the 'Add Devices' button or the plus icon at the top right of the page.

Please note: The number of Smart Drivers that can connect to the app is unlimited.

2. Register

Follow the on-screen instructions to register an account. Once registered please log in.

3. Creating a Home From the Home page press the icon at the bottom right of the page to access the Me page.

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Devices can be added manually or via the Auto Scan feature. Important: Ensure that a light is plugged into Channel 1 when adding a device.



4.1 Adding Devices Manually

From the Add Device page, press the lighting icon at the top left of the page. **Important:** Turn the driver on at the beginning of this stage. If the driver has already been installed in your property, please turn the lights on by flicking the switch on the wall.



Enter your WiFi details and press the 'Next' button. Please note that the app runs on 2.4GHz only. For more information about this, press the blue link.







Once the lights are flashing quickly, return to the Sensio app and check that it says 'EZ Mode' in the top right corner of the screen.

At this stage you will need to press the 'Wifi pairing' button on the top of the smart driver 4 times and then wait 10 seconds until the lights begin to flash rapidly (approximately on/off once per second). If the lights are flashing slowly, press the button a further 4 times until they begin to flash quickly.

At this stage you will need switch the Smart Driver off and on four times, pausing for 2-4 seconds between each flick of the switch. After approximately 10 seconds, the lights should begin to flash rapidly (approximately on/off once per second). If the lights are flashing slowly, flick the switch a further 3.5 times until they begin to flash quickly. If they do not, turn the lighs off for 30 seconds and try again.





If it says 'AP Mode' in the top right corner press on it to open the drop down menu and then select 'EZ Mode'.

Once you have confirmed that the page is set to EZ Mode press to confirm that the lights are flashing quickly and proceed to press the 'Next' button.





Known networks will be joined automatically. If no know networks are available, you will be asked before joining a new network.



The Smart Driver will connect to the App. If the Smart Driver does not connect, please follow the on-screen instructions to retry, or visit the device pairing FAQs.

Once connected, you have the option to assign the Smart Driver to a room and you can also edit the name of the Smart Driver by pressing the pencil icon next to it.

Caution: If you are planning to connect your smart driver to a smart device for voice commands, we do not advise changing the Smart Driver name. Instead we recommend that you change the driver name in the Alexa or Google Home App. For more information see pages 9 and 12.





At this stage you may need to configure your WiFi by pressing the 'Configure WiFi' button at the bottom of the page.

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Once connected, you have the option to assign the Smart Driver to a room and you can also edit the name of the Smart Driver by pressing the pencil icon next to it.

Caution: If you are planning to connect your smart driver to a smart device for voice commands, we do not advise changing the Smart Driver name. Instead we recommend that you change the driver name in the Alexa or Google Home App. For more information see pages 9 and 12.





5. Controlling the Smart Driver

Once your Smart Driver has been successfully connected to the App it will be displayed on the Home page under the 'All Devices' tab. The Smart Driver will also be displayed under any rooms it has been assigned to. In the example above the Smart Driver has been assigned to the kitchen, so it appears under the 'Kitchen' tab.

From the home page you can turn the Smart Driver on/off using the power icon at the side of the Smart Driver tab, or you can press the Smart Driver box to access the Control Menu.

On the Smart Driver Control Menu page the lights plugged into each port of the Smart Driver are displayed in the green boxes as channels. Channel 1 controls ports 1 and 2, Channel 2 controls ports 3 and 4, and Channel 3 controls ports 5 and 6. Each channel can be controlled individually by using the slider bars and buttons.

Schedule 1

Select the settings you want to configure your schedule.

In the example above two schedules have been created. Schedule 1 has been configured so that the lights plugged into Channel 1 turn on at 10:00 and Schedule 2 has been configured so that the lights plugged into Channel 1 turn off at 10:30.

Please note: Any saved schedules can be edited here.

you can create a schedule for all of the channels (lights) as a group. Simply press on the option that

you want to create a schedule for. Once you have selected an option, press the 'Add' button to

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configure a new schedule.





5.2 Lighting Scenes

Scenes are a great way to group your lights together and control them all at once. For example, you may wish to create one group for your task lighting such as under cabinet lights, and a second group for your mood lighting such as plinth lights.



6. Connecting to Alexa and Google Assist From the Smart Driver Control Menu, press the pencil icon at the top right of the page.



From the Smart Driver Control Menu, the Scene Overview page can be accessed by pressing the icon at the bottom left of the page.



Press the Alexa or Google Home icon.



On the scene overview page you will see four preset scenes. To select a scene, simply press one of the scene icons and a green circle will appear around it.



To edit a scene you must first press the scene icon so the green circle appears around it and then press it for 2+ seconds.



You will now be able to choose which channels you want to be active in the scene and how bright/dim you want the channel to be. Press 'Confirm' to save the scene.





Press the 'Link with Account Password' button in the centre of the page and you will be presented with a series of on-screen instructions. Follow the on-screen instructions until you have successfully paired the Link-Sensio App with the Smart Life skill on your Amazon / Google device.



7 Setting up Devices with Alexa After you have linked the Smart Life Skill with the Link Sensio App, press the 'Discover Devices' button.

Your Amazon Alexa will have discovered the Smart Driver and all of its channels, which will appear as separate devices.

8. Alexa - Create a New Group Groups on the Alexa App are very similar to lighting scenes on the Link-Sensio App. They are both great ways to group your lights together and control them all at once. The only difference is that groups in Alexa can be controlled by voice commands.

For example, you may wish to group your lighting by room, zone, or type of lighting.

Please note: It is possible to assign lights from the same driver to different groups.



From the Home page click to access the 'Devices' page by pressing the icon at the bottom of the page.

Select 'Add Group'.



Enter the name for the new group and press 'Next'.



Select all of the devices that you want to be the new group and press 'Save'. **Please note:** Devices can be assigned to multiple groups.





9. Alexa - Editing a Group From the Home page click to access the 'Devices' page by pressing the icon at the bottom of the page.



From the Devices page all groups are displayed in colour boxes. Scroll to the group you wish to edit and press on it to select it.



Press the 'Edit' button at the top right of the screen.



Select the devices you want in the group by

using the tick boxes and press 'Save'.



10. Alexa - Changing Device/Channel Names When Alexa discovers a Smart Driver all of the devices are displayed with default names. To unlock the full potential of your Smart Driver we advise that you rename each device. Not only will this enable you to control each device with voice commands, it will help you keep your groups organised.



Press on the device you want to change to open the device control page.

From the device control page press the cog icon at the top right of the page to acess the device settings page.



From the device settings page press 'Edit Name' under the device name.

Voice commands by channel... Alexa, turn on/off kitchen Channel 1 Alexa, set Channel 1 to 50 percent Alexa, brighten/dim Channel 1 Alexa, set Channel 1 to Warm White

11. Alexa - Voice Commands Once you have successfully set up all of your devices you will be able to use the voice

commands above to control your lighting.



12. Setting up Devices with Google Home After you have linked Smart Life with the Link Sensio App, the Smart Driver and all of the channels will appear as separate devices.

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At this stage you will need to set up each device individually. To do this, press the device you want to set up so it is highlighted in blue and then press 'Next'.

Choose the home that you want the device to be assigned to and press the 'Next' button.



Choose the room that you want the device to be assigned to and press the 'Next ' Button. **Please note:** You do not have to set up all devices, but we advice that you do.

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Once all of your devices have been set up they will be displayed on the Home page under the room you have assigned them to.



13. Google Home - Creating a Room

Rooms on the Google Home App are very similar to lighting scenes on the Link-Sensio App. They are both great ways to group your lights together and control them all at once. The only difference is that rooms in Google Home can be controlled by voice commands.

For example, you may wish to group your lighting by room, zone, or type of lighting.

Please note: It is possible to assign lights from the same driver to different groups.





From the Home page press the account icon at the top right of the screen.

From the Account page press 'Assistant settings'.



From the settings menu scroll down the page and select 'Home control'.





From the Home Control menu scroll sideways to the 'Rooms' tab.

From the Home page all of the rooms that have devices assigned to them will be displayed. Scroll to the room you want to edit and press the room title. In the example above the Kitchen room has been selected.

14.1 Changing the Room Name From the Room Settings page you can change the Room name by pressing on it.





Select the devices that you want by ticking the circles in the top right corner of the device box. Press 'Next' to save.

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15. Adding Additional Smart Drivers

If you add any additional Smart Drivers to the Link Sensio App, they will appear automatically on the Home page under the heading 'Linked to you'. You can add the new devices to a room by pressing on them and selecting a room. Alternatively, you add the devices to a room by following stage 14.



From here you will be able to change the name of the device, reassign the device to a different home and reassign the device to a different room.
