- You must have at least the following items of personal protective equipment: goggles; dust mask - a minimum of FFP3(s) protection; ear muffs or plugs giving protection to reduce exposure to 87 dB(A) at the ear; Safety boots/wellingtons; industrial quality gloves.
- A personal first-aid kit should be available.
- This machine must not be used by young persons, or by anyone under the influence of


