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

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

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Using the Wallpaper Stripper

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- 1. Wear your gloves
- 2. Each section of wallpaper treated will be very hot. Take care while handling it.
- 3. Switch off and remove the plug then allow the equipment to cool down completely before refilling.
- Always place the boiler unit on a heat resistant drip tray and not on a decorative 4. surface. Make sure the steam plate is placed on a heat resistant drip tray when not in use.
- 5. The part that stays hot longest is the filler cap. Allow it to cool then remove it carefully with a protective glove or cloth. Remove it in stages, allowing any pressure to release slowly.
- 6. Keep the cable clear of any sharp edges in your work area.
- 7. If you think the cable may be cut or damaged in any way, switch off and unplug at the mains before inspecting it. If the cable attached to the wallpaper stripper is damaged, stop using the equipment. Contact the hire company. If an extension cable has been damaged, do not use it again.
- Take care not to accidentally pull the plug from the socket. 8.
- Switch off and remove the plug from the socket then allow the equipment to cool 9. down before leaving unattended.
- 10. Switch off and remove the plug then allow the equipment to cool down completely before emptying.
- 11. If your equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company.
- 12. You may want to read this leaflet again. Please keep it until you finish work.
